Step 1: Creating your FSA IDs

- Parent and Student both need an FSA ID. This ID is how you sign the FAFSA form.
- Parents must have their own email address (we can create a Gmail address right now if needed)
- Remember to keep track of your challenge question answers.
- Once you have created your FSA ID, email yourself the information so that you have it saved
